



GIFTED & TALENTED in GEOGRAPHY at SHSSFC

Identification

Geography initially identifies Gifted and Talented students in Year 7. Following the introduction of base line testing those students with a score of 100 or more will be identified.

At the end of each academic year the register will be reviewed with students added or removed accordingly.

Students on the register (8 - 13) will remain subject to them meeting the criteria of additional involvement.

Enrichment

Opportunities for enrichment that are G & T specific are:

Educational visits – Year 7 Natural History Museum, Year 8/9 Centre of Alternative Technology, Year 9 HPQ, Year 10/11 GCSE fieldwork, and Year 12/13 A Level fieldwork.

In the summer term G & T 10/11 attend a one day conference with the focus on researching current Geographical issues

Year 12/13 support Lower School lessons and trips, they also have the Geographical Review magazine available

Extension

Both Geography classrooms have a G & T box with extension task materials and reading matter. Work completed during lessons and homework has extension tasks which they are encouraged to attempt.

Additional sessions are offered on Thursday lunchtime and on Tuesday evening after school.
