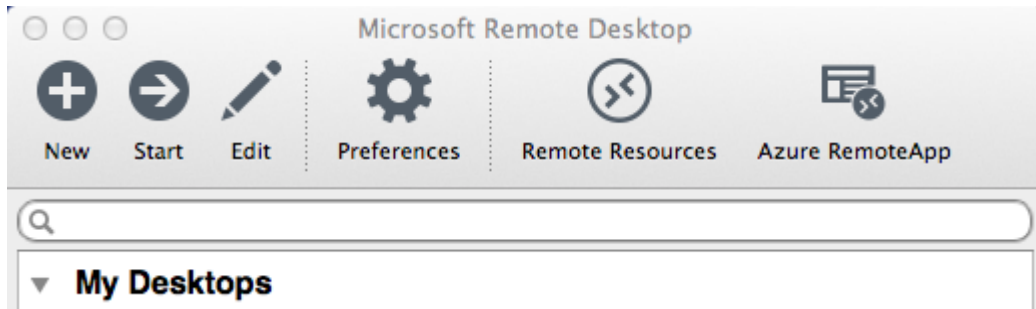

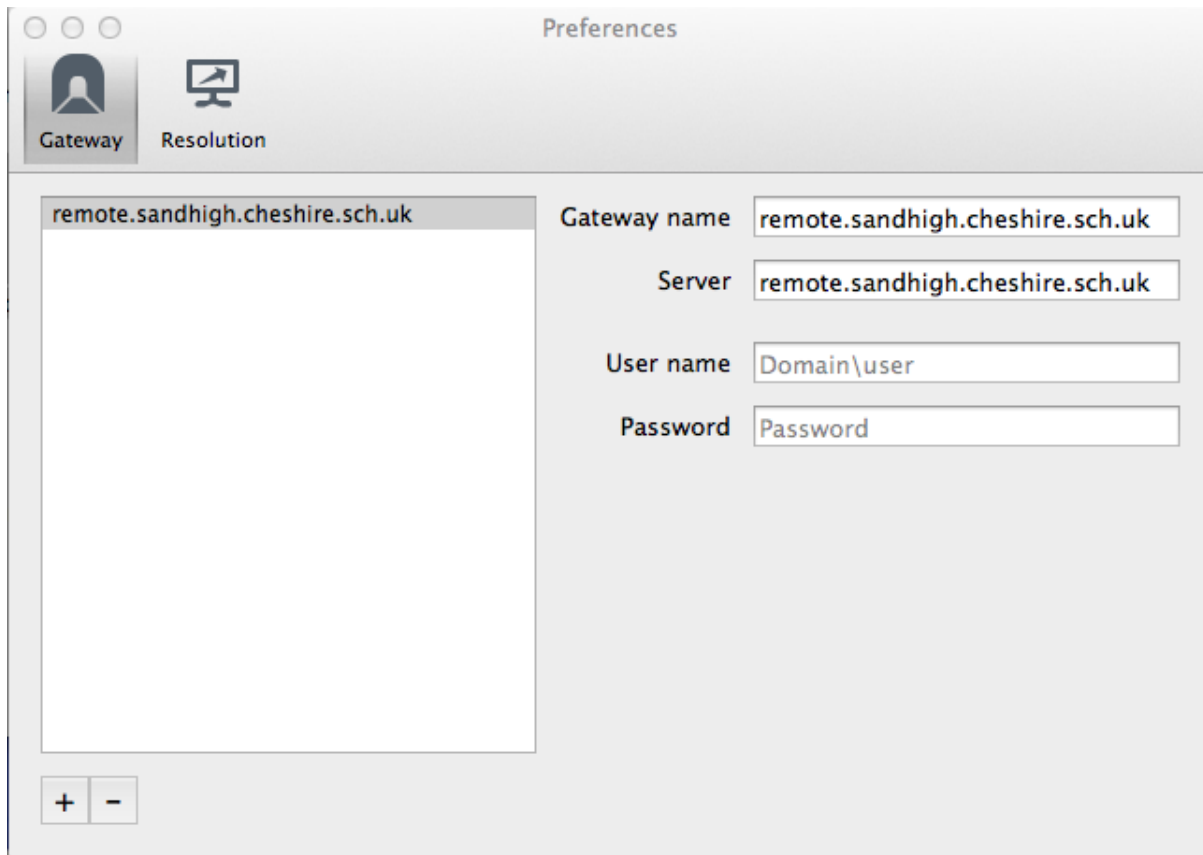

Click on Preferences

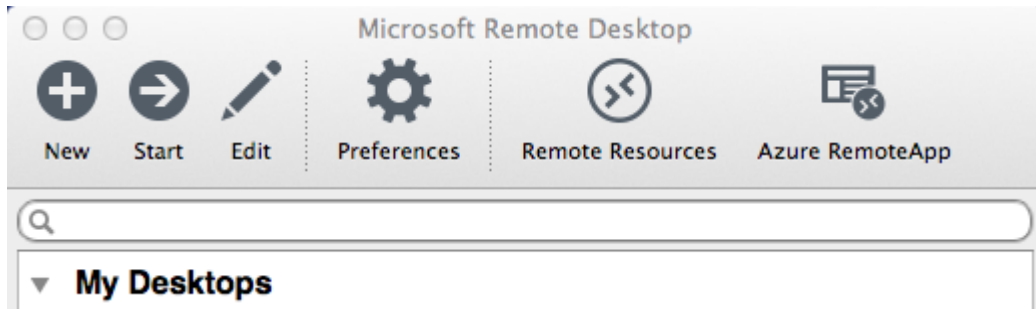


Click the add (+) button and enter the details as shown below then close the window



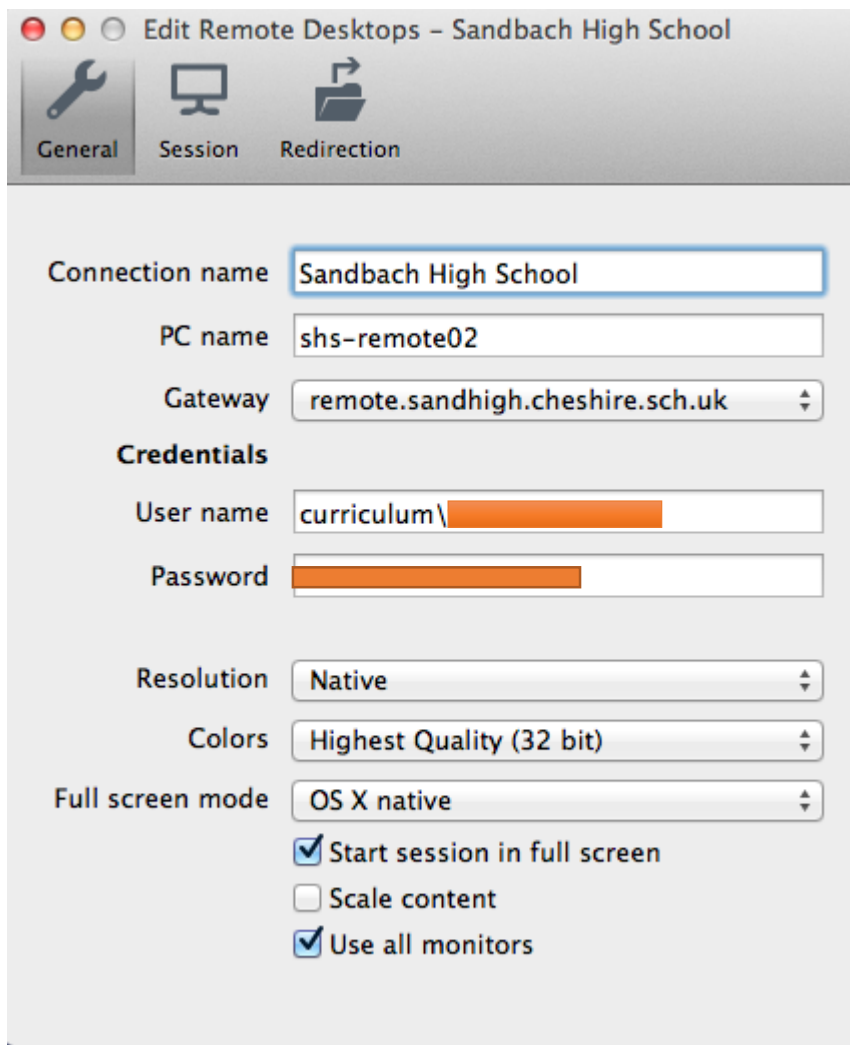
## Creating a new connection
